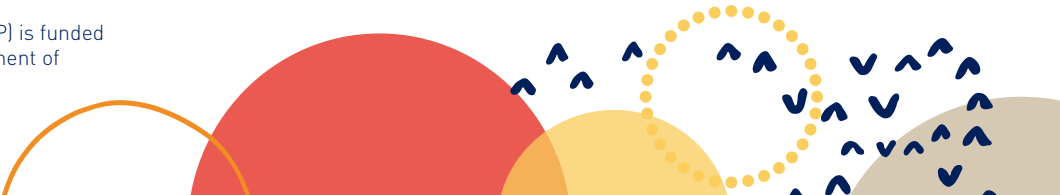

## ONE FOR ALL CHILDREN

The **Victorian Inclusion Agency** (VIA) delivers free inclusion support services under the Australian Government's Inclusion Support Programme (ISP).

Our goal is meaningful participation for all children in education and care. We help early and middle childhood services to support children with additional needs, such as:

- > Children with a disability or undergoing assessment
- > Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander children
- > Children from culturally and linguistically diverse backgrounds
- > Children from refugee or humanitarian backgrounds
- > Children with serious medical conditions
- > Children presenting with language and speech delays
- > Children presenting with disruptive behaviour.

## ONE FOR ALL SERVICES

The VIA is a valuable go-to for eligible education and care services including:

- > Long day care
- > Outside school hours care, including vacation care
- > Family day care
- > Occasional care
- > Multifunctional Aboriginal Children's Services (MACS).

We also work with In Home Care services when supporting children to move into mainstream education and care.

With 14 offices and 60+ Inclusion Professionals across Victoria, the VIA helps services to:

- > Be ready to include every child
- > Have positive, productive relationships with families and proactively reach out to new families
- > Provide quality education and care throughout the day in every setting
- > Reflect the diversity of their community
- > Be confident, connected and partnered with local community services.
