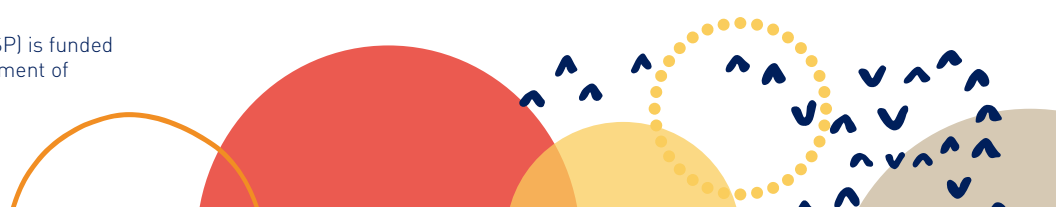

The Victorian Inclusion Agency (VIA) delivers free inclusion support services under the Australian Government's Inclusion Support Programme (ISP).

The VIA is working towards meaningful participation for all children in education and care. We help early and middle childhood services to support children with additional needs, such as:

- > Children with a disability or undergoing assessment
- > Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander children
- > Children from culturally and linguistically diverse backgrounds
- > Children from refugee or humanitarian backgrounds
- > Children with serious medical conditions
- > Children presenting with language and speech delays
- > Children presenting with disruptive behaviour.

The VIA is a valuable go-to for eligible education and care services including:

- > Outside school hours care, including vacation care
- > Family day care
- > Occasional care
- > Budget Based Funded (BBF) services.
